- It is essential that you are accessing your child's online account so that you are keeping up to date with their progress and development.
- Many parents have been very enthusiastic about using it, and are even uploading their own observations from home! This is exactly what we are looking for to ensure that we know your child as best as we can!
 - Please like and comment on your children's observations, and let us know what you think - it is so important that we know whether or not you have read the observations.
- All key-people (Jo, Ann and Emily) have office time once per week. So check regularly for updates! Every observation is assessed before it is sent to you. Please pay close attention to the areas and stages of development. This is how you will know whether or not your child is meeting the expected norm.

Your child's development will be discussed with you during termly 'parents evenings'. But please remember that our door is always open, and you can arrange an appointment with your child's key-person at any time you wish! Your child's key person will do the same if they feel there is something they wish to discuss.

 Parents, grandparents and other close relatives are welcome to access each child's account, and can contribute to their development records once parental permission is given.

Parents Voice Sheets

As you know, we regularly observe your children at preschool to inform us of where they are in their level of development. It's really important that you share with us the things they do at home too, so that we can accurately support your child. 'Parents Voice' sheets will be sent home the week before your child's focus week, so that you can contribute to their assessment. **Please ensure you return it with your comments**.

Home Learning Sheets

At the end of each half term (i.e. six times per year) you will receive a copy of your child's Summative Assessment. This will give you a summary of the level of learning and development we believe your child is at. Alongside this, you will also receive a 'Home Learning Sheet'. This will have suggestions for activities you can do at home to support your child's learning.

Please ensure you return it with your comments.

Reminders

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Please bring one piece of fruit for the fruit bowl each week for your child to share at snack time.
Please bring your child a bag with spare clothes in it, as we are running low on supplies. If you have any of our clothes at home, please can you return them to us ASAP.
